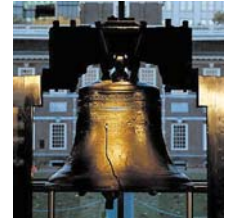


Day 1 Philadelphia, PA

Transfer to the Boise Airport for your flight to Philadelphia. Arrive this evening and check into your hotel for the night. Enjoy a welcome dinner tonight. (D)

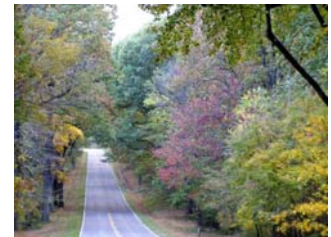
Day 2 Gettysburg

Enjoy a tour of the “city of Brotherly Love” this morning. Sights include the Liberty Bell, Constitution Hall and Independence Center, Betsy Ross House, the Rocky Steps, City Hall and more. Then travel west through the Amish Country and on to Gettysburg. July 1-3, 1863 saw the tides of war turn as Union forces defeated Lee’s southern army. This forced southern troops to retreat back to Virginia. Enjoy a guided tour of the battlefield before checking into your hotel for the night. This evening dine at the historic Dobbs House. (B,D)



Day 3 Harper’s Ferry and Harrisonburg, VA

Travel to Harper’s Ferry, site of the famous John Brown raid on the Federal Armory in 1859. Continue on to the Shenandoah Valley. Visit New Market Battlefield where young cadets from nearby VMI fought seasoned Union troops and won the day for the Confederates. Overnight in Harrisonburg. (B,D)



Day 4 Appomattox and Charlottesville

Visit Appomattox Court House where Gen. Lee surrendered to Gen. Grant in 1865 to end the most violent conflict in American history. Continue north to Charlottesville to see the University of Virginia and Monticello both designed by President Thomas Jefferson. You will also visit Ash Lawn, home of President James Madison and his wife Dolley. She is credited with saving many portraits and artifacts from the White House before it was burned by British troops during the War of 1812. Overnight in Charlottesville and dine at historic Michie Tavern tonight. (B,D)



Day 5 Pamplin and Richmond

Travel to Pamplin to see the Museum of the Civil War Soldier. Considered the finest Civil War museum in America, re-enactors bring history to life with demonstrations of army and camp life in the 1860s. Later visit the Museum of Civil War Medicine. Continue on to Richmond and check in for the next two nights. Dine tonight in the historic Shockoe Slip area. (B,D)



Day 6 Richmond Sightseeing

Guided tour of Richmond features the White House of the Confederacy, Hollywood Cemetery, Monument Avenue, the Reconciliation Monument, Richmond Battlefield Center, Virginia State Capitol and St. John's Church where Patrick Henry gave his famous "give me liberty or give me death" speech. Tonight enjoy dinner on the banks of the James River (B,D)



Day 7 Washington, DC

Travel north to Chancellorsville where Stonewall Jackson was fatally wounded by his own troops in 1863. You are near Spotsylvania Court House and the Wilderness Battle sites. Continue on to Manassas, site of the first battle of the war, a Confederate victory. One year later, a second battle was fought on the same site resulting in a Union victory. Then visit Arlington National Cemetery, the final resting place of more than 144,000 soldiers, statesmen and presidents. You will also see the Custiss-Lee Mansion, the former home of Gen. Robert E. Lee. Check in to your downtown hotel for the next three nights. (B,D)



Day 8 Washington Sightseeing

Meet your local guide for a tour of our nation's capital. Sights include the US Capitol, White House, World War II Memorial, Vietnam Memorial, Kennedy Center, FBI Building, Ford's Theater, Washington Monument, Lincoln Memorial, Jefferson Memorial, National Cathedral and more. This afternoon visit Mt. Vernon, the home and final resting place of America's first president, George Washington. Enjoy dining on the banks of the Potomac River this evening. (B,D)



Day 9 Smithsonian Institute and more.



The day begins with a visit to the Newseum. The Newseum — a 250,000-square-foot museum of news — blends high-tech with history and offers visitors an experience that blends five centuries of news history with up-to-the-second technology and hands-on exhibits.



Then the balance of the day is reserved to visit the wonders of the Smithsonian Institute and other sites in our nation's capital. Tonight enjoy a farewell dinner. (B,D)

Day 10 Homeward Bound

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Boise. Upon arrival, transfer back to Burley where your Fields of Valor tour will conclude. (B)
