America's Road, the Route 66 tour
September 8 -20, 2019



Day 1 Departure Day-Sunday September 8th

Transfer to the Boise airport to begin your Route 66 adventure. Fly to Chicago and arrive late afternoon. Meet your tour director and driver and transfer to your hotel. Check in to your deluxe hotel for the next two nights. This evening enjoy a welcome dinner. (D)

Day 2 Chicago Sightseeing-Monday September 9th

Meet your local guide for a tour of the Windy City. Sights along the way include Grant Park, Soldier Field, the Old Water Tower, the Amaco Building, Navy Pier, the Michigan Avenue, and more. You will also see the sign marking the beginning of Route 66.



While on tour learn about Chicago's gangster lore. Then go to the Willis Tower. At 110 floors and 1450 feet tall it is the tallest building in the U.S. Enjoy 360 degree views for the Skydeck on the 103rd floor. Later today take a scenic cruise along the Chicago River for wonderful photo opportunities of the city skyline and its impressive array of skyscrapers. Tonight enjoy dinner in Chicago. (B,D)



Day 3 Springfield and St. Louis-Tuesday September 10th



Begin your Route 66 journey today as you depart Chicago. Pass through Joliet, home to the Illinois State Prison, and look for the billboard for the Blues Brothers. Travel south and stop in Springfield, IL to see the gravesite and museum of Abraham Lincoln. Continue on to St. Louis and take a ride to the top of the Gateway Arch. Overnight in St. Louis. Dine tonight in the Hills District. (B,D)



Day 4 Tulsa, OK-Wednesday September 11th

Stop in Springfield, MO to see the home of Bass Pro. Continue on to Miami, OK to see the restored old Coleman Theater. Built in 1929, it was the most elaborate theater between Dallas and Kansas City. Later visit the Will Rogers Museum. The humorist and actor was a native son of Oklahoma. See the Blue Whale in Catoosa and continue on to the Tulsa area and check in for the night at the Hard Rock Casino. Enjoy dinner in Toby Keith's I love this Bar & Grill. (B,D)



Day 5 Oklahoma City-Thursday September 12th

This morning see the Golden Driller statue dedicated to those in the oil drilling industry. Continue on Route 66 to Arcadia and stop at Pop's Diner. Arrive in Oklahoma City to visit the National Cowboy and Western Heritage Museum. Later see The Oklahoma City National Memorial and Museum dedicated to the victims, survivors, and first responders of the bombing of the Murrah building in 1995. 168 people were killed in the attack with many of them being children. Check in for the night and enjoy dinner in



Oklahoma City. (B,D)

Day 6 Amarillo, TX-Friday September 13th

Travel west today and stop in Elk City, OK to visit the Route 66 Museum. Continue on into the panhandle of Texas. In Amarillo, see the gleaming Helium Memorial. Helium was discovered here in the late 1800s Later visit the American Quarter Horse Museum. Overnight in Amarillo. Dinner is at the Big Texan Steakhouse. Do you recognize anyone on the wall of fame that has completely eaten a full dinner featuring a 72 ounce steak? (B,D)



Day 7 Albuquerque, NM-Saturday September 14th

Travel to Albuquerque today. Visit the Turquoise Museum located in the Zachary Castle. Here you will see some of the most beautiful turquoise pieces in the world. You will also see the International Balloon Museum plus the Balloon Grounds where the Balloon Festival will take place in early October. The Festival features thousands of hot air balloons with early morning mass launches and impressive evening glows. Check in for two nights in Albuquerque. (B,D)



Day 8 Santa Fe-Sunday September 15th

Take the short ride to the state capital of Santa Fe. Founded 1610, it is one of the oldest capital cities in America. See the Palace of the Governors and Loretto Chapel. You will have free time to stroll the Native Market and the Plaza of the Governors. Return to Albuquerque and take the Sandia Peak Tramway to the top of the Mountain. The peak is 10,378 feet above the desert floor providing stunning views. Dinner is included tonight. (B,D)



Day 9 Williams, AZ-Monday September 16th

Travel west today into AZ and on to Winslow to see the Meteor Crater. A meteor struck here nearly 55,000 years ago leaving a 700 foot deep and a mile wide crater. Then it is on to Flagstaff. Stop to visit the Powell Observatory. The mini planet Pluto was discovered from here in 1930. Continue west to Williams on old Route 66 and overnight there. (B,D)



Day 10: Los Angeles-Tuesday September 17th

Travel west across southern Arizona to Kingman to visit the Route 66 Museum. Continue on to California passing by Palm Springs. Arrive at the Santa Monica Pier where Route 66 ends, lunch is included. Check into Disneyland's Grand Californian Hotel for the next three nights. Dinner is on your own tonight. (B,L)



Day 11 Sightseeing-Wednesday September 18th



Santa Monica Pier might be the official end the *Route* 66 but our tour continues for the next two days at “Disneyland”, America’s favorite theme park! 2 day passes are included for both Disneyland and California Park.

Walt Disney was born in Chicago in 1901 and traveled the famed Route 66 to Los Angeles where he produced his first short film, Steamboat Willy, and his fame grew and finally in July 1955 Disneyland was opened! Take a stroll down main street Disney enjoying the “Great Moments with Mr. Lincoln” animatronic show, ride on the Disneyland Railroad, or tour Main Street in an old fashioned trolley car. Step back in time in “Frontierland” and “Adventureland” or a step into the future in “Tomorrowland”! The Grand Californian Hotel opens directly into *California Adventure Park* . California Park opened in 2001 and features many wonderful shows, restaurants, and the spectacular World of Color nighttime water and light show on Pixar Pier. It also features *Cars Land* based on the animated fictional town of Radiator Springs-another small town (fictional) on *Route 66*. In *Cars Land* the main street is Route 66 and features wonderful restaurants and the Golden Vine Winery. The day is free to relax and enjoy the sights and sounds of Disneyland and California Adventure Park! (B)



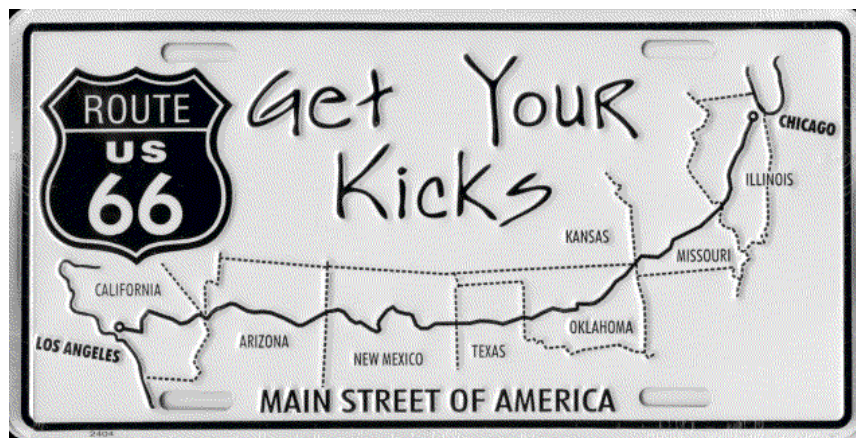
Day 12 Disneyland-Thursday September 19th

LEVEL 1:

I like to keep walking to a minimum and avoiding stairs when I can. I can walk up to a mile per day over primarily level ground with short periods of standing.

LEVEL 2:

I'm comfortable walking one to two miles throughout the day. I expect to get on and off of a motor coach, and I'm ready to stroll through cities and walk over uneven pavement. I can stand for up to 30 minutes and climb one to two flights of stairs.

LEVEL 3:

I like to spend much of the day exploring and be out and about on a coach with my days full. I can walk two to three miles per day and stand for long periods of time with no difficulty. Stairs don't bother me, and I love to keep up with the group.

LEVEL 4:

I am a fit traveler and am capable of easily walking three miles or more during the day. I would like my days to be filled with active pursuits for one to three hours at a time. I can walk on uneven and rocky terrain, including small hills.

LEVEL 5:

Walking is the best way to get to know a new place. I'm energetic and enjoy a challenge. I'm always ready to spend the day on the move. I am fine with uneven surfaces, inclines, stair climbing, windy or wet conditions at sites, and long periods of standing. I expect some of the experiences to occur in the evening with very long days.
